Interested Parties:

Pursuant to a request, I conducted a Computerized Lie Detection Examination with examinee Louis Talley, in regards to his opinion of specific events of the past two decades.

During a paralinguistic pre-test interview, the examinee and I thoroughly discussed the relevant issue (listed below as questions). All terms and words to be used in the relevant questions were understood by the examinee and

then defined by the examinee to my satisfaction. Examinee claimed to be in good health, had consumed no medicine/narcotics or alcohol recently, had no pain or discomfort at the time of the examination, and was well-rested (also claimed to have had a full night of sleep the night before).

At the conclusion of the paralinguistic pre-test interview, an acquaintance test was conducted. This test was used to prove to both the examinee and to myself that the examinee was suitable for this examination. Adequate recordings of the examinee's physiology and verbiage were obtained during this portion of the examination, so the testing continued.

A comparison-question test was then conducted using standardized techniques developed by the US government and the private lie-detection/truth-verification industry. Every piece of the equipment used was inspected and functionality-checked per standards for the day of this examination; all functions were satisfactory. Multiple examination charts were collected. The testing was recorded with the permission of the examinee.

The examinee was asked the following requested relevant questions on each collected chart (*shown with answers given by examinee*):

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1. During the last part of 1993 through 2004, did two-way paranormal communication take place between you and some original members of KTLA-5 TV Morning News, Los Angeles ? YES
Barbara Beck? YES
... with Sam Rubin? YES
... with Jennifer York? YES
... with Sharon Tay , in 2004? YES
... with Carlos Amezcua? YES
2. Did Sam Rubin had to confirm this to you, having written that you did not do magic tricks, Sam pointing at the camera and said "Yes you do do magic tricks."? YES
3. Did Sam call it a "psychic" connection. YES
4. Did this communication had to take place on a live broadcast on either TV or radio? YES
5. Did others take part in this such as Dr James Dobson, Chuck Smith of Calvary Chapel, Raul Reis, Greg Laurie and Dr Gene Scott? YES
6. Was there a comment by Gene Scott "I know you are talking to me but can't understand what you are saying, but it feels good? YES

CONCLUSION / OPINION:

After carefully analyzing and computer-reviewing the collected charts and notes, it is the opinion of the examiner/analyst that there was **no deception indicated** during the examination.

These results indicate that the examinee was not being deceptive when answering the relevant questions above.
